Born on 18 July 1950 in Gdynia. From 1973 he has been an academic employee of the University of Gdańsk at the Faculty of Economy – from 1992, on the position of associate professor. In 1992-1995, visiting professor in the Center for Russian and East European Studies (CREES) at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor (USA), and in 1998-2001, lecturer at Central European University.

In the 1980s he cooperated with the underground press, and was an author of commentaries in *The Wall Street Journal*. At the same time he was associated with the editorial team of the *Przegląd Polityczny* quarterly. He publishes economic commentaries in the *Rzeczpospolita* and *Gazeta Wyborcza* dailies.

In 1999-2004, he discharged the function of chief economist of Bank Pekao S.A. In 2004-2010, he was a member of NBP's Monetary Policy Council.

From March 2010 to December 2014, member of the Economic Council at the President of the Council of Ministers.

In 2006, President of Italy nominated him a Knight of Ordine delia Stella delia Solidarieta Italiana.
